The project enabled direct cooperation, a meeting of representatives of twin cities (50 people from Tomaszów Lubelski and 50 from Grigiszkow in Lithuania)

The meeting took place in Tomaszów Lubelski (Poland) from 12/09/2024 to 15/09/2024

The first day of the visit to Tomaszow Lubelski by the delegation from Grigiszkow began with a Conference entitled "Europe yesterday and today - what does membership in the European Union give us?" concluded with a debate on EU membership. The next item was a workshop, during which cultural development in the Tomaszów Lubelski region with the use of EU funding was presented on the example of facilities in the Tomaszów Lubelski area. Another item on the agenda was a workshop, during which the thematic blocks of the "Partnership for Sustainable Development" agreement were developed. The group participating in the activities both on the part of the guests and the hosts consisted, among others, of representatives of schools, NGOs and local government units, who were eager to speak and exchange experiences from their activities in Poland and Lithuania. The conclusion of the first day of the delegation's stay was participation in an integration meeting, which allowed the project participants to get to know each other better and exchange contacts.

The second day began with a workshop on the organization and operation of an information point for refugees. During the visit there was also the issue of tolerance. Discrimination based on religion of faith was discussed. Of great interest was a debate dedicated in particular to Eurosceptics entitled "A Nation Alone or Unity of Nations?", enhanced by a multimedia show on the benefits of EU membership. The next item on the agenda was a workshop, during which a plan was developed - an integrated program of partnership activities for peace - conflict-free dispute resolution. The participants then worked on ways to monitor needs for the development of the "Partnership for Sustainable Development" agreement.

The next day of the visit of the delegation from Grigiszkow to Tomaszów Lubelski began with a workshop, during which they worked on partnership activities to prevent aggression and violence in the community and then on the "Partnership for Sustainable Development" document. The workshop culminated with a tour of the trail of warfare in the Tomaszow Lubelski region during World War II and discussions on war migration and war migrants. The day ended with a discussion of development prospects using the opportunities offered by membership in the European Union.

On the last day of the visit, the Partner Cities Festival took place - a presentation of the cultural achievements of the project partners. During the visit there was also a patriotic aspect. Participants took part in the anniversary celebration of the Battle of Tomaszów Lubelski. A meeting with NGOs discussed the role of NGOs in building tolerance. The conclusion of the four-day visit of the Gregorians to Tomaszów Lubelski was the signing of the "Partnership for Sustainable Development" agreement and talks about the upcoming plans for cooperation. It was agreed that representatives of the City of Tomaszów Lubelski will revisit Grigiszkow in order to draw the attention of the local community of Grigiszkow to the issues raised in the project, to evaluate the developed effects of the project and to introduce possible changes.
